Purpose

To outline the use, procedures, record keeping of materials deposited at and management of the Red Willow Lagoon.

Statement

The County of Stettler operates and maintains a waste lagoon in the Hamlet of Red Willow. This lagoon has facilities to accept wastewater from outside users. It is in the County of Stettler's best interests to restrict the amount and type of materials that are deposited into the Red Willow Lagoon on a daily basis by various companies in the area.

Procedure

For reference to this Policy, Applicant shall mean any company or individual that wishes to deposit any type of material into the Red Willow Lagoon.

The Applicant will be available to access the Red Willow Lagoon upon completion of a Waste Water Lagoon Access Application (attached) to be completed each month stating that they wish to deposit materials into the Red Willow Lagoon. The Applicant shall also pay a fee for each month of said access, as per the County of Stettler's Fee Schedule Bylaw.

The Applicant must declare that:

1. The Applicant is responsible for the security of the waste facility when the applicant is utilizing the facility.
2. The Applicant is responsible for safe handling of waste to the facility and is responsible for any damages (environmental or physical).
3. The Applicant will keep a log sheet of all locations where it has received waste to be hauled and dumped at the County of Stettler waste facility. This is to be forwarded on a **monthly** basis to the County of Stettler Office.
4. The County of Stettler will have the right to review the log sheet of the Applicant at the discretion of the County of Stettler.

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5. **Only household wastewater will be accepted.**
6. The Applicant will pay a fee for the hauling of waste to the County on a monthly basis.
7. The Applicant will be responsible for the waste that is deposited at the County of Stettler wastewater facility. No contaminated wastewater will be transmitted to the facility. The Applicant will be responsible for clean up costs.
8. The Applicant will abide with all regulation of the County of Stettler.
