### HIGHLIGHTS FROM COUNCIL

- The first round of 2023 Community Investment Program applications were presented in front of Council. Council chose to fund partially, or completely, eight of the nine applicants. Congratulations to the groups who received funding.
- Council agreed to sign the updated Stettler Regional Emergency Management Agency Agreement, this agreement will now be sent out to our regional partners for their decision.
- Administration publicly discussed and confirmed the decision to modify access to the cardboard and household recycling bins. These bins, currently located at the Stettler Transfer Site, Big Valley Transfer Site and Donalda Transfer Site, will be moved to Erskine and Botha in February.
- The public hearing for **Bylaw 1687-22: Amendment to the Municipal Development Plan** took place during the Council meeting. After hearing all received public feedback, Council passed the second and third readings and **Bylaw 1687-22** was passed.
- Council chose to decline contracts for the second and third phases of the Gadsby Waterline Project.
